
Dear Phillip:

I am writing this letter to express my concerns about the most disturbing situation with the Vietnamese Scouters in exile. We have received in Geneva voluminous correspondence from various Scout units or councils from Australia, the United States, France, Canada and other countries. All these correspondents claim to speak in behalf of the former Scouts in Vietnam and most of them present themselves as the sole authentic representative of Vietnamese Scouting.

The World Organization of the Scout Movement has a policy with ethnic or exile groups and it would be desirable if we could settle the problem of Vietnamese Scouts in exile along these lines -- that the registration of Vietnamese troops be anchored in their respective host country since the boys belonging to these troops were born in the host country and are, or will soon become, citizens of the host country. In France and the United States, particularly, there is a written policy anchoring this registration but allowing these groups to maintain a reasonable degree of Vietnamese identity and even wear the Vietnamese colors on their shirts.

For various reasons we cannot and will not recognize any exile group representing their country of origin or the Boy Scout Association of Vietnam. In order to avoid confusion and provide meaningful opportunities for Vietnamese youth, we would suggest to you the creation of a central committee of Vietnamese Scouting in exile. You, as the last president of the Boy Scouts of Vietnam, and Mr. Tran Van Khac, founder of Scouting in your country of origin, should play a unifying role in this tentative. If you are forming such a group, we can have a single interlocutor and solve earlier the multiple and delicate problems raised by the exile of Vietnamese Scouts who spread out all over the world. Needless to say, I would be ready to give any complementary information in a meeting if this could help to solve the problem about which I am speaking in this letter.

Dear friend,

It has now been ten years that I have been following Vietnamese Scouting's activities overseas - as did my predecessor Laszlo Nagy - and, in particular, those of the Central International Committee of Vietnamese Scouting.

As an old saying goes, "of tradition, let us keep the flames and not the ashes". This is, my dear brother Scout, what you are trying to do by keeping the flame of Scouting alive outside of your country, a Movement which was once fully alive in your country. In general, you do so by becoming integrated within the National Scout Organizations in the countries where you are, while striving - quite rightly - to preserve what is specific to Vietnamese Scouting, namely its language, customs and traditions, within the framework of the host structures. You do so while willing to be able to bring back the flame to your country when conditions permit Scouting to be independent, apolitical, in conformity with the purpose, principles and method of World Scouting, as Scouting used to be back home, when it was still possible to be so freely.

The day will come, I am sure, when Vietnam will have the democratic structures which will enable its youth to organise itself freely, without the influence of the authorities, the party or the government. Scouting will, of course, be at the service of the nation, but it will also be open in spirit to the world, to all cultures and all religions, as required by the Constitution of the World Organization of the Scout Movement.

However, as you know, some of your brothers continue to offer Scouting in Vietnam, more or less in hiding, and sometimes at personal risk. However, under such conditions, the time has not yet come when Vietnamese Scouting could envisage being recognised at world level and officially become a member of the great family of the World Organization of the Scout Movement once again. In effect, for Vietnamese Scouting to become an official member again one day, it will need to have the guarantee of independence and of the respect of fundamental principles of Scouting which the present authorities are not prepared to give.

In the meantime, what you must do is to keep alive the flame of Vietnamese Scouting overseas. You, yourselves, cannot become an official member of WOSM, except through the National Scout Organizations of the countries in which you live and where these exist - but you can be members in spirit, as your aim, principles and method are those of Scouting.

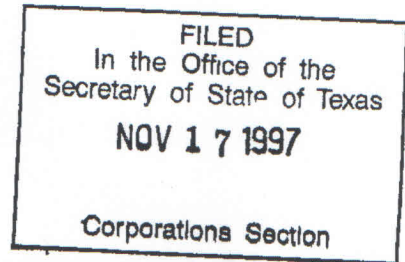

OF

HOI DONG TRUNG UONG - HUONG DAO VIET NAM (HDTU-HDVN) INC.

We hereby associate to form a Texas Non-Profit Corporation under the provisions of article 1396-3.02 of the Texas Non-Profit Corporation Act (Volume 3, Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes). as amended, and to that end, set forth the following:

ARTICLE I

The name of the Corporation is

HOI DONG TRUNG UONG-HUONG DAO VIET NAM, INC., sometimes referred to as the "corporation."

ARTICLE II

The corporation shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE III

The Corporation is formed to promote friendship, solidarity, and mutual assistance among former Vietnamese Boy and Girl Scouts living in the United States of America;
To preserve and enhance Vietnamese culture, tradition and customs through cultural and community activities.

ARTICLE IV

Said corporation is organized exclusively for educational, cultural, charitable, and other similar non-profitable purposes, as contemplated by Section 501(c)(7) of the internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law). No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, directors, or any other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payment and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article III hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statement) and political campaign of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or the corporation, contributions of which are deductible under 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

The Corporation may solicit and receive funds and property by gift, transfer, devise or bequest, and may administer and apply such funds and property only in the furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article III hereinabove.

The Corporation shall do any and all lawful things which may be necessary, useful, suitable or proper for the furtherance or accomplishment of the purposes and powers of the Corporations of similar character, including the power to own, lease, contract for the purchase and sale of , and to mortgage or otherwise encumber, real and personal property.

ARTICLE V

The initial registered office of the Corporation is to be located at 6930 Cloud Swept, Houston, Texas 77086. The name of its registered agent is Harold Hai Do, who is a resident of Texas.

ARTICLE VI

The affairs of the Corporation shall be managed by the Board of Directors. The initial number of directors of the corporation shall be Three (3). The number of directors may increased or decreased from time to time by a amendment to the by-laws. The directors shall be elected by a majority vote of delegates of members at the annual and/or special meeting, as may be provided for in the by-laws.



INTERNATIONAL CENTRAL COMMITTEE OF VIETNAMESE SCOUTING

The undersigned, pursuant to Chapter 10 of Title 13.1 of the Code of Virginia, do hereby state as follows:

ARTICLE I

The name of the Corporation is International Central Committee of Vietnamese Scouting (hereinafter referred to as the "Corporation").

ARTICLE II

The Corporation is organized and will be operated exclusively for charitable and educational purposes, including, for such purposes, the elimination of prejudice and discrimination, the defense of human and civil rights secured by law, and the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as tax-exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding section of any future United States internal revenue law (the "Code"). In pursuance of these purposes, the Corporation shall have the powers to carry on any business or other activity which may be lawfully conducted by a corporation organized under the Commonwealth of Virginia's Nonstock Corporations Act (the "Act"), and to do all things necessary, proper and consistent with maintaining tax exempt status under section 501(c)(3) of the Code.

ARTICLE III

The registered agent is Lan Thuy Le, who is a resident of the state of Virginia and an initial director of the Corporation, and the address of its initial registered office, which is identical to the business address, is 6066 Leesburg Pike, Suite 170, Falls Church, VA 22041, which is physically located in Fairfax County.

ARTICLE IV

The Corporation may have one class of members, the qualifications and rights, including voting rights, of which shall be designated in the Corporation's Bylaws.

ARTICLE V

The internal affairs of the Corporation shall be regulated by its Board of Directors as described in the Corporation's Bylaws. The Bylaws shall set forth a minimum number of directors that may constitute the Board of Directors. The actual number of directors constituting the Board of Directors shall, from time to time, be determined in the manner set forth in the Bylaws.

The Nominations Committee designated by the board shall place the names of qualified members as candidates for director positions before the annual membership meeting. General members may recommend, in writing to the Nominations Committee, qualified members for election to the board. Elections for the board of directors shall be conducted at the annual membership meeting.

The number of directors constituting the initial Board of Directors is three (3), and the names and addresses, including street number, of the persons who are to serve as the initial directors until the first annual meeting, or until their successors are qualified and elected, are:

ARTICLE VI

No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributed to any director, employee or other individual, partnership, estate, trust or corporation having a personal or private interest in the Corporation. Compensation for services actually rendered and reimbursement for expenses actually incurred in attending to the affairs of this Corporation, as set forth in Article II hereof, shall be limited to reasonable amounts.

No substantial amount of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation (except as otherwise permitted by Section 501(h) of the Code and in any corresponding laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia) and this Corporation shall not intervene in (including the publishing or distributing of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

ARTICLE VII

In the event of dissolution or final liquidation of the Corporation, all of the remaining assets and property of the Corporation shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all of the liabilities and obligations of the Corporation and for necessary expenses thereof, be distributed to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable or educational purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code (or the corresponding provision of any subsequent federal tax law) or to a state or local government for a public purpose, as the Board of Directors shall determine. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the Corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes, or to such organization or organizations as said Court may determine which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes. In no event shall any of such assets or property be distributed to any member, director or officer or any private individual.

ARTICLE VIII

To the fullest extent permitted by the Act, as now in effect or as may hereafter be amended, and subject to the limitations, if any, set forth therein, no officer or director of the Corporation shall be personally liable for damages in any proceeding brought by or in the right of the Corporation, or brought by or on behalf of the members of the corporation, or in connection with any such claim, action, suit, or proceeding to which he or she may be or is made a party by reason of being or having been an officer or director of the Corporation, provided, however, that such relief from liability shall not apply in any instance where such relief is inconsistent with any provision of the Code applicable to Corporations described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Code.

The undersigned certify that we have read the above statements and that the same are true and correct to the best of the undersigned's knowledge, information and belief.
